District 742 Preschool Classes 2011-12

District 742 Preschool classes are available to children of all ability levels and are staffed by licensed preschool teachers and paraprofessionals. Class sizes are kept small in order to provide individual attention for each child. Children must be 3 or 4 years of age (and toilet trained) by September 1, 2011 to participate. All classes will begin in the fall of 2011 and follow the school district calendar. Register early...classes with low enrollment may be canceled.

Cost per month: **\$140.00 for 2 half days each week** **\$340.00 for 3 full days each week**
 \$170.00 for 3 half days each week **\$456.00 for 4 full days each week**
 \$228.00 for 4 half days each week

Limited financial assistance is available for families who qualify and participate in parent-child classes. There will be many choices to accommodate parent schedules. (Call Jan at 253-5828, ext. 5750 to apply for School Readiness financial assistance.)

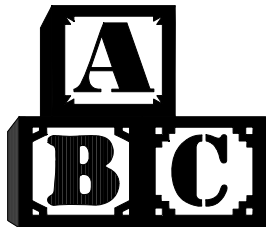
